Just to confirm that it is an offence for anyone to remove licenced asbestos material without a licensee. The consequences of such an action coming to HSEs attention would depend on the evidence and circumstances but would be likely to involve enforcement (given the risk and the prescriptive legal controls). HSE sets out the decision making principles in the Enforcement Policy Statement. http://www.hse.gov.uk/pubns/hse41.pdf
