Just to confirm that it is an offence for anyone to remove licenced asbestos material without a licensee. The consequences of such an action coming to HSEs attention would depend on the evidence and circumstances but would be likely to involve enforcement (given the risk and the prescriptive legal controls). HSE sets out the decision making principles in the Enforcement Policy Statement. <http://www.hse.gov.uk/pubns/hse41.pdf>

The HSE enforcement decision making process is in the Enforcement Manage Model <http://www.hse.gov.uk/enforce/emm.pdf> The outcome of such considerations can include revoking a licence and/or prosecution and/or enforcement notices.
